
## Adams Square I



This wallpaper map, published by O. A. Adams in 1929, presents the world in a square. Conformality fails at the four corner singularities, where angles are halved or quartered, and four differently oriented copies of the world map meet. The singularity at the south pole makes a supercontinent with four Ross Shelves and four Antarctic Peninsulas washed by four Weddell Seas.
