
Ring of Fire on the Limb



A fishy fact about this orthographic perspective: there are eleven 10° intervals on each radius, where one expects nine. The continents have been conformally squeezed into one hemisphere by a droop as on the $\underline{2010}$ card to make them visible in perspective, for a more three-dimensional effect than the $\underline{1992}$ ring-of-fire card.

The Latin greeting reveals tardy creation of holiday-season cards that year.
